Ages 0-17 | Log Your Reading!

1	Register for the Summer Reading Program Pack your free literacy book bag!
2	Start Reading! Record all reading minutes on the reading log
3	Turn in your reading log at least once a week if you can! Turn them in as often as you like, anytime during our hours of operation! Receive additional beads, brag tags, stickers, and more!

What counts as reading? Everything!

Your child can read, aloud or silently, to him or herself, to a sibling, pet, stuffed animal, friend, parents, grandparents, etc.

If your child peruses a book and makes up his or her own story, reads silently, views the pictures silently or tells the story out loud, reads the back of a cereal box, attends a program at the library, reads a stop sign – **everything counts!**

*Encourage reading by having books in every room!
Swap them out (as well as keep the favorites)!*

Read ~ Read ~ Read | Earn Reading Points, Beads, and More!

1	Earn one bead for every 5 minutes of reading
2	Earn a sticker for every 30 minutes you read
3	Earn another 'brag tag' for every 60 minutes you read
4	Earn an additional snap bracelet for every 5 hours (300 minutes) you read
5	Earn a special 'snake' snap bracelet when you have read for 10 hours (600 minutes) [Limit 2]
6	Earn your choice of an additional free book for every 10 hours (600 minutes) you read
7	Schedule "snacks with the staff" when you have read for 10 hours (600 minutes) [Limit 1]
8	Earn a free Summer Reading Program t-shirt when you have read for 12 hours (720 minutes) [Limit 1]
9	Complete the Nature Scavenger Hunt and earn 30 beads (scavenger hunt card must be picked up at the Library)
10	Attend a program and earn double reading beads (calculated at 5 minutes per story, times 2) Some programs include more than one story. Some programs also include specialty beads!

- In order to receive your information packets and reading incentives, registration must take place in the Library. If you are an Auburn resident and are unable to travel to the Library due to mobility or other reasons, please contact the Director at jcollins@town.auburn.ma.us
- You may register your child anytime during the Summer Reading Program; the program runs from Friday July 8th – Saturday August 20th 2022. Friday August 19th is the last day to register. We will calculate all reading logs at the Finale. If you are unable to stop in on Saturday August 20th, please do so as soon as possible in the days prior to, or after that date.
